



Proposed Features for Building & Parking Design, 8-28-16

Improves Fellowship Hall

- Combines Fellowship Hall and Gathering Hall into much larger space
- Opens Fellowship Hall completely to Gathering Hall and entry
- Creates better circulation: eliminates need to use Fellowship Hall as hallway
- Addresses pyramid sound and solar heating issues
- Redesigns and moves kitchen to be more functional; adds pass-through window into Fellowship Hall/ serving counter in Fellowship Hall

Increases parking

- Adds parking in new lot (28 more spaces, expansion room)
- Adds walking path through woods from new parking area to building
- Adds entrance-exit to new parking lot from Cheatham Road with safer egress onto Timothy Road

Refurbishes RE area

- Creates teen room that may also be used by other groups
- Updates existing RE classrooms and nursery
- Updates existing restrooms on RE hall

Creates new meeting spaces

- Adds new 50-seat multi-purpose room
- Adds new, separate classroom/conference room

Improves Sanctuary

- Reconfigures sanctuary to add up to 60 more flexible seats
- Addresses acoustical issues in Sanctuary
- Improves audio-visual and lighting issues in Sanctuary

Improves exterior aesthetics and function

- Adds new, larger glass-walled entrance that conveys openness and welcome
- Adds new landscaped entry plaza
- Revamps playground
- Adds new signs and lights in parking areas and street entrances

Addresses problem areas

- Increases flexibility in utilization of space throughout building
- Increases and organizes storage
- Redesigns and enlarges administration office area; places at front of building for security
- Adds ADA gender neutral restrooms, one with a shower, near Sanctuary

Next Steps Calendar for the EOV Project

- **October 16** – Town Hall to discuss Financial Feasibility Study outcome, Capital Campaign, and building plans.
- **Sunday, Nov 6** – Congregational Meeting to approve a building plan and goal for the Capital Campaign.
- **December 2016-January 2017** - Combined Capital/2017-2018 Annual Budget Campaign.
- **February/March 2017** – Possibly further tweaking of plan based on actual amount raised.
- **March 26, 2017** (tentative) – Congregational Meeting to approve final plan.
- **April – May 2017** – Final construction plans; choose contractor
- **June 2017** – Begin construction
